

.kpn File – General Description

The **.kpn** file defines a structured container that groups images and audio recordings with session metadata. These files are designed to be processed by the **Engine**.

Each **.kpn** file includes:

- A folder “**Images**” containing the **images**
 - A folder “**audio**” containing **optional audio files**
 - A **JSON file “metadata.json”** containing essential **metadata** required by the Engine
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Structure - metadata.json

The JSON file contains the following sections:

1. Metadata

The **metadata** object includes:

- **descriptor** – Identifies the file type
- **schemaVersion** – Specifies the schema version of the format
- **compatibility** – Defines compatibility information for version control

2. Session Information

- **sessionId** – The unique identifier of the session to be analyzed
- **step** – Indicates the step number within the session workflow

3. KPN File Information

The **kpnfile** object contains:

- **order** – The sequence number of this .kpn file within the step
- **status** – The current status of the file transmission

This allows proper tracking of multiple .kpn files associated with the same step.

4. Source Information

The **source** object contains information about how and where the .kpn file was generated.

5. Time Information

The **time** object includes:

- **start** – Capture start timestamp
 - **end** – Capture end timestamp
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6. Images

The **images** object contains image-related metadata:

- **width** – Image width
- **height** – Image height
- **format** – Image format (e.g., jpg, png)
- **orientation** – Image orientation metadata

Additionally, it includes a **list** array, where each element contains:

- **order** – Image sequence number
- **filename** – Image file name
- **timestamp** – Timestamp of image capture

- **eyetracking** – Eye-tracking data:
 - **x** – Horizontal gaze coordinate
 - **y** – Vertical gaze coordinate
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7. Speech

The **speech** object contains speech capture and transcription data:

- **language** – Detected language
- **accuracy** – Confidence score of speech recognition
- **text** – Full transcribed text

It also includes a **list** array containing:

- **timestamp** – Timestamp when the word was detected
- **word** – The detected word
